THELMA ROE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Attended Cherry Street Youth Center as a Child)

ELIGIBILTY:

The student must have **attended** Cherry Street Youth Center on a regular bases for one school year. Applicant must be a graduating senior and plan to continue his/her education at a vocational technical school, a two-year community college, or four-year college or university. The student must be a full-time student at the school he/she will be attending.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:

Each scholarship will be in the amount of \$500; payable to the student and the college in the amount of \$250 per semester. Individuals seeking scholarship funds must make application by March 7th for the fall academic year.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

The selection committee will take into account and consider the following matters concerning each applicant.

- A. High school academic record of a GPA not less that 2.0 for attendance at a two-year or four-year college, 1.75 for vocational applicants.
- B. Volunteerism at Cherry Street Youth Center. Call the Center, 431-2161, for details concerning volunteering during your senior year if you have not previously volunteered.
- C. A statement by the applicant of his/her career plans.
- D. Short essay answering the question, "What difference did Cherry Street Youth Center make in my life?"

SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL FOR SECOND SEMESTER:

Applicant must submit a copy of their college fall semester transcript showing a GPA of 2.0 of higher, 1.75 for vocational school, when applying for the second half of scholarship payment for spring semester. The transcript must be submitted no later than January 15th. The \$500 scholarship in non-renewable.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

Selection of scholarship applicants will be determined by the Board of Directors of Cherry Street Youth Center, Inc. All decisions of the selection committee are final and incontestable.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

All scholarship applications must be submitted by March 7th for consideration for fall semester scholarships and January 15th for spring semester scholarships.

NOTIFICATION:

Announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made during the annual Chanute High School Awards Ceremony.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Applicant must be complete the attached form in detail and return this to the Chanute High School Guidance Office by March 7th. A personal interview with the scholarship committee may be requested.
