
We want to say a special thank you to the individuals and families that helped fund the remaining cost of this project!

Serving others is a big value we focus on with our middle school program. The kids were eager to help sort donations for the victims of the recent apartment complex fire here in town. We were also able to donate the use of some of our extra Cherry Street tables for the clothing drive.

Though none of our children currently attending any of our programs was directly impacted by the fire, it has been quite an impactful experience. Several of our children (especially the younger ones) have needed to talk about the fire and fire safety. Or they will retell stories they have heard from the night from others in the community. One example being how mom's and dads were throwing their kids over the fences (railing of the balcony on the 2nd and 3rd levels) to safe them. Many of the children drive by the burned complex everyday on their way to or from school. It is a fearful sight. Praying for everyone each day has been very important for the children.

SUMMER is Coming!

We are nearly finished with our summer plans for 2024. We will have 8 weeks of summer fun! We will again get to attend VBS at the 1st Baptist Church and have two weeks of swimming lessons.

Each week will have a theme through out the summer.
